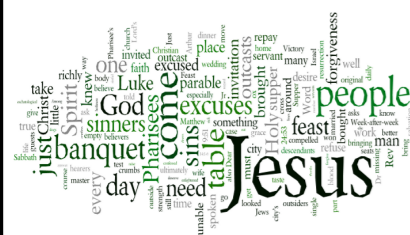

Our Parish Mission begins Sunday 8th September and we ask you to help us spread the word, to reach out and tell your neighbours and friends. It has been many years since we last had a parish mission so it will be a very special week for our parish. The mission team will be led by two lay women, Helena Connolly and Fodhla Mc Grane, with Masses celebrated by our own priests. A lot of people have been involved in the planning and preparation of our mission and we pray that it brings many blessings and produces much fruit for the time ahead. Our Mission Team plan to visit the schools, nursing home and offer prayer ministry throughout the week. During the Mission, morning Mass will be celebrated in both Churches (7am Mass will end at 7.30am sharp to allow those who are working and going to school to attend), and after the 9.30am Mass and 10am Mass, a cup of tea will be provided with biscuits/cakes. We ask you to stay with us after morning mass and enjoy a cuppa! Our evening Mission will not celebrate Mass, but is a time for prayer and devotion where we sing and pray together. Our evening mission services focus on themes relevant to all our lives (healing, family life, forgiveness, our values, remembering our beloved dead). We have many people involved in our evening para-liturgies and much work has went into the preparation and delivery. May God guide the work of our team, our parish and our priests.
