## **MESSAGE FOR LENT 2019 FROM POPE FRANCIS**

'For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the children of God' (Romans 8:19). He reminds us that the mystery of salvation is already at work in us through our earthly lives; that our journey from one Easter to the next is a journey towards the fulfilment of the salvation we have already received as a result of Christ's passion, death and resurrection – his paschal mystery. This mystery also involves history and all of

Pope Francis opens his message with the words of the Preface of today's Mass, referring to 'this joyful season when we prepare to celebrate the paschal mystery with mind and heart renewed... as we recall the great events that gave us new life in Christ' (Preface of Lent I). The call to conversion, therefore, is a call filled with life and hope and, also, a call that challenges us to St. Mary's Hall, Maguiresbridge from 11.30am, £10 per renew creation by turning away from selfishness and selfabsorption and to show solidarity with our brothers and sisters in need. In this way, we will renew creation.
