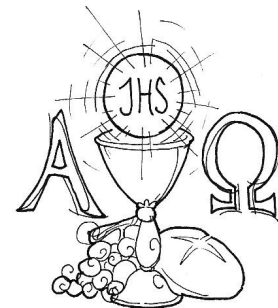

On Sunday 30 June next, Deacon Kevin Connolly from the parish of Donagh, Co. Monaghan, will be ordained to the priesthood by Bishop Larry Duffy in St Macartan's Cathedral, Monaghan, beginning at 3pm.

Deacon Kevin is extending an open invitation to all to attend and participate in the ordination liturgy in the Cathedral on that day. On the following day, Monday 1 July, he will celebrate his first Mass in St Mary's Church, Glennan, Glaslough, Co Monaghan at 7pm. Once again, everyone will be welcome.

The ordination of a priest is a great event in the life of the diocese and for the parish community. As a diocese, we give thanks to God for the gift of priesthood itself and, especially, that Deacon Kevin has answered "Yes" to God's call to serve the people of God in our diocese. We pray that others will do likewise, so that, through priesthood, the diaconate, religious life and other ministries, they may build up the community of faith that is the Church and be witnesses to Christ in the world.

This ordination liturgy will also be historic in that Deacon Kevin will be the first priest to be ordained by Bishop Larry Duffy.

In Holy Cross Cemetery we have erected a memorial dedicated to all children who died through illness, accident, still birth, miscarriage, or however. We will pray mass in Holy Cross on Sunday next 23rd June at 3pm, and then bless the memorial.

WHAT WE CAN DO ABOUT CLIMATE CHANGE: Reducing our carbon footprint and save money at the same time. This is Our responsibility-Small changes add up. Low cost tips: Draught excluders around windows and doors could save between £20-30 per year also saving 650lbs of carbon dioxide (CO2). Insulate your home and save £120 per year. Switch off – don't leave appliances on standby and save between £45 and £80 a year. Turning down your room thermostat by just one degree can save £75 and 1400 lbs of CO2. You can save over £43 a year by just being careful how you use your kitchen appliances. Don't fill your kettle right up every time-just boil the amount of water you need. Do not leave the hot tap running. Set your washing machine to wash at 30 degreesC and save 500lbs CO2. Through installing a water-efficient shower head, a family of four could save around £65 a year. Changing even to one energy-saving light bulb can save 150lbs of CO2 per year. Replace your old fridge with an Energy efficient one: annual savings of over £50; save 700lbs of CO2. With solar panels save £770 per year. Drive just 10 fewer miles a week-annual savings £48, Save 520lbs of CO2. Reduce, Re-use, Repair, Recycle.
