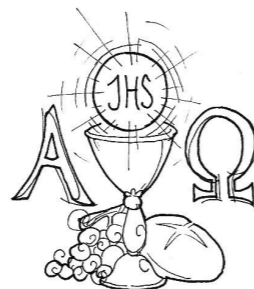

ORDINATION OF BISHOP-ELECT DUFFY next Sunday at 3pm in St Macartan's Cathedral, Monaghan. You can watch the ordination live via the web cam in the cathedral. OUR NEW BISHOP: Monsignor Larry Duffy is from the parish of Magheraclone in South-Monaghan. He was born (in Ballybay) on 27 November 1951, the son of the late Thomas and Elizabeth Duffy. He has three surviving siblings - Anna, Patrick and Peter. His other brother Brendan died just over two years ago. Our new bishop received his early education at Ballynearn National School and at the Patrician High School, Carrickmacross. Having completed his studies for the priesthood at St Patrick's College, Carlow, he was ordained in St Macartan's Cathedral, Monaghan in 1976 by Bishop Patrick Mulligan. Since then he has served in various parishes including Enniskillen, Castleblayney, Monaghan & Rackwallace, Ederney, Clones and Carrickmacross. In addition, he also spent four years working in the Diocese of Kitui in Kenya. A former player with Magheraclone Mitchells GAA, Bishop-elect Duffy is also an avid GAA fan and a keen golfer.

Inspire us to act justly and to reverence all God has made.

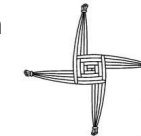
Brigid you were a voice for the wounded and the weary.
