Good Reading in Church: When arriving at the Ambo, pause for a moment, and then announce the reading. After each reading, pause again for a few seconds, look up at the congregation and then say, **"The word of the Lord"**.

It is not necessary to introduce the Psalm with words like "Our response is". Begin reading the Psalm simply by reading the Response, and then let the congregation repeat it. When you finish each verse, look up at the congregation, inviting them to respond.

At the end of the second reading, pause again and then say, **"The word of the Lord"**.

Further guidelines for good reading in Church are available in the Sacristy.
