Parish Covid Committee: As promised we have continued to review our regulations within the Parish. We also take this opportunity to say a sincere thank you to the amazing group of Ushers who have provided us with a safe place for over two years, we thank them for their commitment and good humour, this was so much appreciated during that difficult time.
