The tradition follows that on the Fourth Sunday of Advent, next weekend 21st/22nd December, children and adults bring their Baby Jesus figures from their homes to their local Church where they are blessed. Parishes around the world now join in the celebration,  $\sqrt{\phantom{a}}$ encouraging young children to make the connection between the Nativity set at home and the local church where they worship each weekend. "It helps children and young people to prepare for Jesus." (Pope Francis) A suggestion is, following the blessing, take your 'Bambinelli' home, wrap it and open it as a family on Christmas morning where the youngest member of the family would place it in the crib.
