RE-OPENING OF OUR CHURCHES

With the support of the civil authorities, we hope to have our Churches open for public worship on Monday 29th June. While this is great news, we will not be able to go back to as it was.

From an estimated 500 seats in Holy Cross, we will now have 80 available to us, and from estimated 200 in St. Mary's, we will now have 40 available. That is the number of a congregation, we will now try to facilitate.

Entrance to all **three weekend masses** will be by ticket only, collected at the Parish office during opening hours the previous week. This Parish Policy also enables tracking and traceability to take place, in-case of an outbreak. No ticket will be required for the week day masses.

The Sunday obligation to attend mass continues to be suspended, you can therefore attend any of the week day masses, and fulfil that.

Best advice at this given time is that people who are vulnerable or unwell, they should stay at home, and, if possible, participate, as now, via webcam. The same applies to those who have been in recent contact with someone who has the virus, in accordance with public health advice. This is now part of our Parish Covid-19 Policy.

With regards to the wearing of masks: we request that everyone entering the Church for Mass wears a mask, this reduces the risk of infection greatly.

All the required safety procedures are now in place in both Churches, two-meter distancing, sanitizers, directional signage, weekly deep sanitizing of the entire building etc. We ask that you adhere to all of these arrangements in the interest of your own safety, and that of others.

We are inviting all members of our community to volunteer as readers, Eucharistic Ministers and ushers, a particular welcome to our young people.

For those who don't feel safe to come out to Church, and those who were unable to get into Church, because of the restricted numbers, a drive by Communion will take place 10 minutes after the mass has ended, Eucharistic Ministers will be available at the Sacristy door.

On entering the Church, through the **main door only**, (disabled ONLY will be facilitated through the side doors) you will be invited to sanitize your hands, an usher will then take you to your seat, guide you to communion and assist you in exiting. Exiting in Holy Cross through the two side doors, exiting in St. Mary's down the two side aisles. Please co-operate totally with our ushers.

In the Bishops framework document it states that in a Parish which has a number of Churches, consideration should be given as to whether it might be more effective, in terms of facilitating numbers and maintaining a high degree of hygiene, Mass is to be celebrated in the largest Church for the foreseeable future. This means that the usual 10am Mass in St. Mary's will now be celebrated in Holy Cross, where a greater number will be able to attend. In so far as possible this mass should be left free for the St. Mary's congregation. This arrangement will be reviewed after one month.

The Tuesday 7pm Novena Mass will now be transferred to St. Mary's beginning on Tuesday 30th June, for the foreseeable future.
