There is no right or wrong way to grieve, there is no time limit on grief, and we understand that. The team here at the Parish of Aghalurcher have erected White Post Boxes located at the entrance of our beautiful graveyards at both St Mary's Maguiresbridge and Holy Cross Lisnaskea. The white 'Letters to Heaven' post box enables parishioners to write letters, cards and messages to those they have lost and 'post them'. One way which may bring comfort through the grief, is the act of writing down feelings or sharing thoughts on paper, whether it is on the day of an important anniversary or any day of the year, the 'Letters to Heaven' Post box is here to help. That includes letters, postcards, birthday cards, anniversary cards, pictures and drawings from our younger parishioners, any written format that you wish, our post boxes are available to anyone who feels that they may benefit from it. Every letter, drawing and card put into the memorial post boxes will be treated with the utmost respect and confidentiality. The 'Letters to Heaven' are stored securely and never opened or read. The team here in the Parish of Aghalurcher will then have the letters transformed into wild seed cards which you can purchase. The cards can then be planted. Once the seeds start to bloom, you can see them and know that the Spirit and memories of loved ones are never far from our hearts.
