Are you getting married in 2021? At least 12 months before the marriage takes place, the Church should be booked, preferably before the hotel is booked. A Pre- Marriage Course must be booked through Accord. Both couples need to fill out a Pre-Nuptial Enquiry Form, this is completed by the Priest in their home Parish. All these documents must be in the Parish Office at least three months before the marriage. It is norm to meet the Priest on three occasions, 1. To book Church 2. To complete the documentation 3. To finalize the booklet and arrange the practice date and time.
