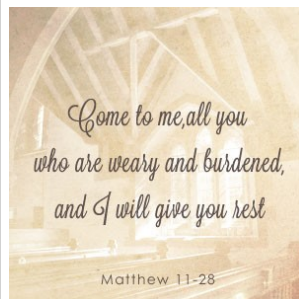

Ushers will now guide you to your seats, to communion and in exiting the Church. **Face masks are compulsory**, and a ticket is required to attend any of the weekend masses, available from the Parish Office during office hours. For those who don't feel safe to come out to Church, and those who were unable to get into Church because of the restricted numbers, a drive by Communion will take place 10 minutes after the mass has ended. Eucharistic Ministers will be available at the Sacristy door. Masses will be as per old schedule except for the Tuesday 7pm Mass will now be celebrated in St. Mary's, Maguiesbridge.

**Eucharistic Ministers/Reader's Rotas** for the month of July, for all parish masses are now available in the Sacristy and on the Parish Website. Please note Tuesday's Mass is in St. Mary's at 7pm (Tuesday weekday rota). Check if you are listed and if you are unable to attend please arrange someone to cover for you.
