## Funeral and Covid Regulations

# Decisions made following our discussions:

### Ushers

- Still in attendance at weekend Masses and Tuesday evening Mass
- ➤ Ushers will be more greeters than ushers welcome people and handing out bulletin
- > Stand down ushers at Communion try for a period and then evaluate
- Not necessarily in yellow jackets anymore, but some form of identity to be decided upon

Keep hand sanitiser. No longer provide masks. Continue to encourage people to wear masks if this is what they want to do. Happy to see people wearing masks. Respect everyone else's space and try to stay apart. One section of one side of the Church will continue to remain for social distancing. Ventilation will continue to happen, open doors and windows. This review to be announced at Masses – emphasise that people can still wear masks if wish to do so
