Matters Arising

Funeral and Covid Regulations

- ➤ There were no reactions from Church Congregations to the relaxation of regulations
- ➤ All positive attitudes
- ➤ Identity Jackets for Ushers/Greeters.
- ➤ Email from the Diocese suggesting the return of Collection Boxes at Sunday Masses. Canon Jimmy uncomfortable with this idea — conscious of the present cost of living crisis and financial strain. Collection is good enough, probably down by about 10%.
- Card Payment: do we need to introduce this facility? Team felt that at present it was not needed
- > Return of Blessed Water to the Font. We will introduce it
- ➤ Majority of people not wearing masks at funerals, congregation all wear masks at the 10 o'clock Mass on
- Weekdays

Parish Mission

- ➤ The first poster/sign has already been erected and people are interested and curious which is good
- Formal letters of invitation have been sent to all Guest Speakers
- > A Cantor has being recruited for the duration of the Mission

Net Ministries

- Parish support team will attend their commissioning Mass in Rosnowlagh in late August
- ➤ The Net Team for Aghalurcher Parish will be commissioned on Cemetery Sunday. They will go into the schools immediately following the Parish Mission
- ➤ CEO and Development Officer returning in August to organise Timetable and tie down final arrangements

- ➤ It was agreed that restrictions on attendance at Baptisms be removed
- Aisling and Vera to inform parents when they are booking baptisms that a maximum of 40 per family can attend the ceremony
- ➤ We will continue to baptise 4 babies in Holy Cross and 2 in St Mary's on the respective Saturdays
