St. Peregrine Novena: Novena Sunday 27th May 2025 to Thursday 1st May 2025. Need one more speaker. Mission team being brought on board

Youth Ministry: Our new youth minister Eamon is doing incredible work. Altar Server teams – 26 children in parish. Parents to be approached re Access NI checks. John Paul II – quite active, 18 in total. Have been helping out at the Relics of St. Bernadette, International Mass, helping at Masses held for Sacraments preparation, All Saints and All Souls day. Commissioning of the team to be organised. P4 Sacraments – helping at Masses at weekend. Street collections for Lisnaskea lights. Will be available to help at switching on of lights. Formal tuition in reading and becoming Eucharistic Ministers. Training course – Youthlink: course for young people to become youth leaders. Commit to training over a number of weekends. Also a possibility of attending Lourdes. We also hope to recruit a 2nd reading in both Churches at weekends – add to bulletin and approach schools.
